Check In/Out Procedure

For the safety and well being of your child we have established the following procedures.

1. **One parent or guardian** must sign their cast member in. Parents with cast members under the age of 10 must escort their child to the designated stage parent. **Please note that only stage parents and stage crew with a name tag may be back stage.** This includes Dress Rehearsals.
2. **You MUST sign out and check-in your cast member's costume with their stage parent.** No cast members are to be released with their costume unless it is your personal property. **Please do not leave any personal items.**

Please note:

- Cast members are not allowed on stage before or after the show without permission.
- Cast members meeting friends cannot "walk through" the audience. They must be checked out and walk around to front entrance of the lobby.
- We are not responsible for any lost items. Please label all personal items
- Bring only what is necessary. **NO FOOD**, only labeled bottle water. Please plan ahead and eat before coming.
- All parents of cast members under the age of 10 are responsible for getting their child to the appropriate stage parent.
- If a special pick up or drop off arrangement (ie. Another parent picking up your child), it is necessary to coordinate with the stage parent at check-in.
- The rehearsal is "closed" meaning no parents, family, or friends are allowed to watch.

ALL DANCERS SHOULD COME DRESSED IN ABT UNIFORM AND PINK TIGHTS WITH HAIR/MAKE-UP COMPLETE (EXCEPT FOR LIPSTICK).

BRING YOUR LABELED COSTUME IN A COSTUME BAG ON A HANGER

The Colony Theatre Parking Information

We are located directly across the street from the former Ikea, at the corner of 3rd Street and Cypress Avenue, just off the I-5 Freeway. **Plenty of free parking is available** adjacent to the building on two sides and underneath, as the building is embedded in the mall parking garage's northeast corner, directly across the street from the former Ikea.

The building is in the middle of a well lighted, secure shopping area, within easy walking distance of a number of excellent restaurants.

The Colony Theatre is "freeway close" as it is right off the I-5 freeway. Many people prefer to use only freeways to reach us; however there are more direct street routes from certain areas (see below).

Once you arrive at the Mall

Enter the parking garage on Third Street, between Cypress and Magnolia. (The sign says "East Garage, 501 N. 3rd Street" and is located next to Burlington Coat Factory) You will be on level 4, which is the one you want. Follow the signs to the Colony Theatre that you will see overhead. Drive to the end of the aisle and make a right. Drive to the end of that aisle and make another right. The theatre entrance is at Section 4e, in the northeast corner of the garage.

When you leave the Theatre

To go north on the I-5: Exit the parking garage turning right onto Third Street, left on to Magnolia, left onto Glen Oaks, left onto Cypress, right onto Third Street, left onto Burbank Blvd, right onto San Fernando Road and left onto the 5 North onramp.

To go south on the I-5: Exit the parking garage turning right onto Third Street, then turn right on Verdugo Road. This street will become Front Street. Pass under the freeway. Turn right onto the 5 South onramp.

To go west on the I-134: Exit the parking garage turning right onto Third Street, right onto Magnolia, left onto Victory, then right onto the 134 West onramp..

There is no eating in costumes, you must wear a robe or cover up. There is no food allowed backstage. All food **MUST** be kept and eaten in the front lobby area of the theatre at the designated time only. **Please plan ahead and bring a sack dinner. There is no time to leave.** *Thank you for your patience.*
- Dismissal:** Dancers not in ACT II are permitted to leave once the cast is released for dinner break. All dancers **MUST** be signed out.
- 7:30pm:** ACT II Run Through Begins
- Dismissal:** ACT I Dancers not in second act are permitted to leave once the cast is released for dinner break. All dancers **MUST** be signed out. ACT II dancers may leave once released by Miss Jen.

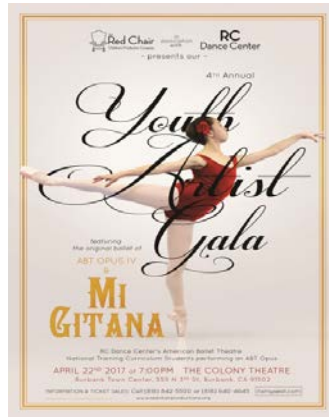
